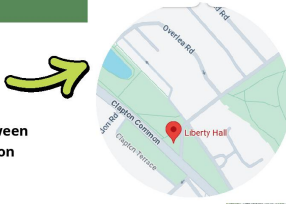

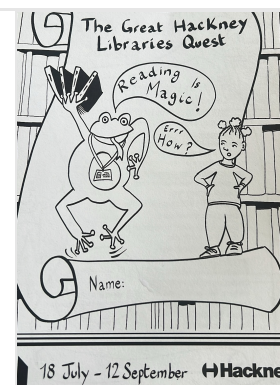
The Great Hackney Libraries Quest

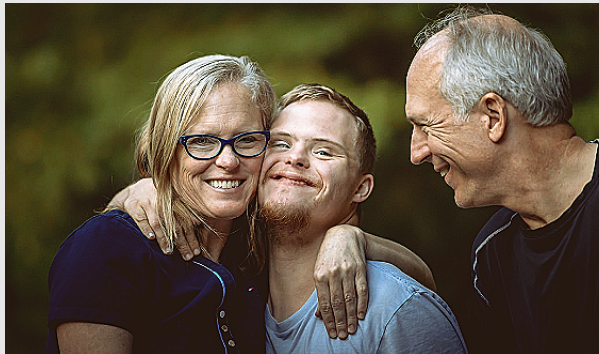
