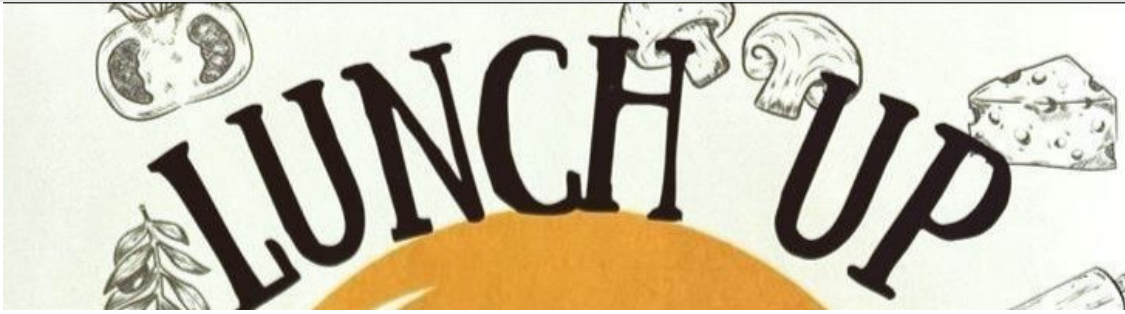


Community Fridge is an initiative aiming to tackle food poverty and waste.

Great sessions where girls from age 5 to 16 can make friends and grow in confidence all while getting involved in fun activities.

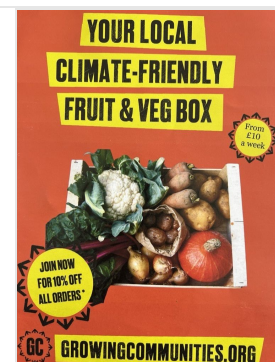

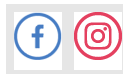
